Mesotherapy is an alternative delivery system of medication developed in 1952 by Dr. Michel Pistor. Mesotherapy is recognized as a medical specialty by the French Academy of Medicine since 1987. Mesotherapy treatments are widely used in Europe and South America as a means of delivering medications for various areas of symptomology.
